The welcome address was delivered by **Dr. B. Mohan Kumar**, Principal, BCCA, who emphasized the relevance of accounting and finance education in shaping future professionals. This was followed by addresses from distinguished dignitaries including **Prof. S. Abhirama Krishna**, Director General, SGGES;

Prof. D. Obul Reddy, Chairman, IAA Hyderabad Branch; emphasized the role of accounting and finance in Viksit Bharat 2047 need and importance in present and future towards Viksit Bharat 2047. He explained the contributions of IAA and Branches role in the field of Accounting and Finance and explained various activities of IAA Hyderabad Branch for the development of students and faculty to enhance their knowledge.

The Chief Guest, **Prof. V. Balakista Reddy, Chairman, TGCHE** addressed the gathering, he emphasized the crucial role of Accounting and Finance in measuring and managing national wealth. He explained that accounting forms the foundation for sound financial decision-making and sustainable economic development. The evolution of accounting and finance—*past, present, and future (Kal, Aaj aur Kal)*—was discussed in detail. Prof. Reddy introduced the 3P's framework – Plan, Perform, and Preserve, highlighting its relevance for institutions and the economy.

Global economic comparisons were made with countries such as the USA, Japan, and European nations. He noted that India is among the top 10 global economic powers and has the potential to become a \$30 trillion economy by 2047, provided it prioritizes innovation, research, and effective corporate governance. India was

described as a “Youth Nation”, where young minds play a vital role in driving economic growth. The importance of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), particularly the role of educational institutions toward society and students, was also emphasized.

The inaugural session concluded with the release of the souvenir by the dignitaries and a vote of thanks proposed by **Dr. M. Janakiram**, Associate Professor of Commerce.

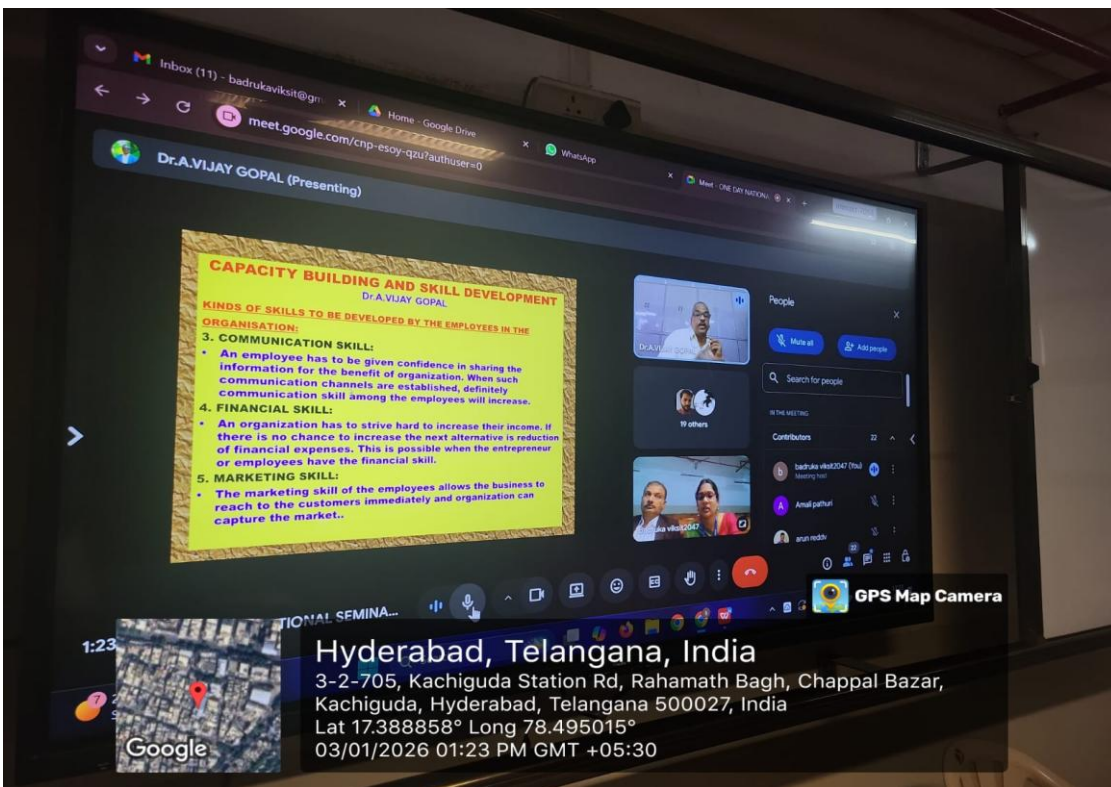
Online Paper Presentation
